	Niushou Mountain is a famous mountain in China known for its natural beauty and cultural significance. Located on the west peak of Niushou Mountain, Usnisa Palace belongs to the pit construction, which is 220 meters long, 160 meters wide, and 89.3 meters high. The single building area covers about 136,000 square meters. It is based on different supporting themes. According to other supporting contents, the outside space is divided into two parts: the large and small dome, meaning external and internal support. The inside consists of nine floors, with six underground beds and three feet on the ground. The six underground floors are made up of the Usnisa Hall and Usnisa Worshipping Palace.
	Thousand-Buddha Hall
	The primary color of Thousand-Buddha Hall is red, yellow, and dark gold, and the plane is elliptic. The whole space is dome-shaped, consisting of 3 floors, with a total height of 28 meters. On its external circle is the Ten Thousand-Buddha Corridor. The layout of the Thousand-Buddha Hall is arranged according to five regional Buddhas of the Avatamsaka realm. The Great Stupa of Usnisa, representing the Vajradhatu Mahāvairocana, is set as the center.
